Last year was a great season for the Tigers as they simply finished undefeated in arguably the toughest conf in the country. They won the SEC Title game and then knocked off VT in the Sugar Bowl. Auburn fans felt they won a National Title like Tommy Tuberville had promised two years ago. This year they lose an amazing four 1st round DC's, the most of any team in the country and they also have a much tougher schedule. Whereas LY they faced just one team with a winning record on the road, this year they will likely face 3 in conf play in Ark, Georgia and LSU, all teams with reputations of being very tough at home. The Tigers also only have 12 returning starters (2nd fewest SEC) and had practically an injury free season last year missing just 9 starts due to injury. They may open the season 5-0 but 4 road games in 5 wks, including the 3 mentioned, will likely keep them from repeating as SEC West Champs.
