Ball St opened up the Brady Hoke era at 4-4 but have gone just 2-13 since. Unfortunately, in the offseason, they lost MAC Frosh of the Year TB Adell Givens, who was dismissed from the squad and then lost their career-leading receiver Dante Ridgeway (1st Tm MAC), who opted to leave early for the NFL. Had Hoke had them on hand, Ball St would have likely finished higher in the MAC West. This year they will probably be beaten up by a brutal opening schedule as they have road trips to Iowa, Auburn and BC in their first 4 games and have just 4 at home all season, including matchups with BG and Toledo which are hardly winnable. Last year's Ball ST team did have 30 frosh & soph on the 44 man 2 deep at year's end but it will be tough for them to improve upon their 2-win MAC total from last year. Keep in mind that Ball St was outgained by an average of 77.7 ypg last year, the 3rd worst mark in the league.
