Boise probably has the #1 rated offense, defense and special teams plus coaching staff in the WAC. They have the fewest amount of lettermen lost (13) and have simply dominated WAC play, going 24-0 the last three years. Last season, they once again outgained league foes by an average of 191.3 ypg and 25.6 ppg. It's almost impossible to go against this juggernaut. This is Boise's best team ever, which is saying something, because last year's squad was 11-0 and ranked #7 at season's end. Boise could be beatable away from the blue turf and that November 12th game is the key to the league standings.
