The Bearcats are one of the most improved teams in the country and could get to a bowl game. Last year the season could have been much better. Taking away the Louisville game, in which they did not have Gino Guidugli and basically mailed it in for the 2H, UC outgained CUSA foes by an average of 118.6 ypg but amazing only finished 5-3 in league play and 6-5 for the season. This year they not only must replace their veteran senior QB in Gino Guidugli but suffer major hits, including losing a 1,000 yard rusher, top 2 receivers and amazingly their top 8 tacklers. They have just six starters back, the fewest in the Big East and play 4 Big East road games. This clearly looks like a rebuilding season for the Bearcats but Dantonio is doing a solid job recruiting and things will be on the upswing in the future.
