Last year the Bulldogs outgained SEC foes by 105 ypg, the third best mark in the league and they also took on one of the toughest schedules in the conference (18th overall). This year they have some large losses to the NFL draft, including QB Greene and DE Pollack. UGA is still a very experienced team with 15 returning starters and the 15 lettermen lost are among the fewest in the league. Mark Richt has been through the SEC wars, whereas Urban Meyer has not. UGA will be favored in 9 of their 11 games with the only toss-ups being a road trip to Tenn and their neutral site game vs Florida, which means they actually have a shot at running the table.
