The battle for the others will be for 3rd. UH was outgained by 67.8 ypg in league play and lose 26 lettermen, including their star QB Timmy Chang. Last year, their defense was injury-ravaged and should be much healthier and stronger this season. We rate UH the 3rd best offense and 4th best D in the WAC. A disturbing trend last season was UH being outscored by 41.3 ppg and outgained by 226 ypg on the road but we see June Jones turning that around this season and the Warriors having a 5th straight winning year.
