Last year they got past both Purdue and Penn St by 2, saw Minny miss a FG on the final play of the game for another 2 point win and were a 7-1 co-Big 10 champ. Provided the replacements on the defensive front are adequate, this team is stronger than 2004's version with an improved O-line. They can only have better health at RB and have one of the best QB's in the country in Drew Tate. They have a tough Big 10 schedule, having to face Ohio St, Purdue and Wisconsin on the road and draw Michigan at home but the Hawkeyes are once again one of the best teams in the Big 10. If they continue to have good fortune and win their close games, they have a shot at getting to that big Rose Bowl game.
