A quick glance shows LT with just 9 returning starters, the fewest in the league and 24 lettermen lost, the second highest. They do have the disadvantage of being the only WAC team that plays in the Central time zone. It would be easy to dismiss their chances for a solid season but this is an LT team that took on the toughest schedule (#60) of the current WAC teams last year. They finished 6-6 despite having to face #4 Miami, #10 Tennessee, #17 Fresno and #6 Auburn in four consecutive weeks. They lose Ryan Moats but should get back to the pass-happy offense of years' past and have good talent on the defensive side of the ball. With an easier schedule than last year, LT has a great shot at finishing in the upper half of the WAC and getting their first bowl bid in 4 years.
