The Tigers had to face 3 Top 25 teams on the road LY in a 4 week span and still finished 9-2 in the reg season and outgained SEC foes by an average of 146.1 ypg, the best mark in the conference. The biggest question we have for LSU is the coaching change, but Les Miles inherits arguably the most talented team in the SEC. Not only is LSU the 2nd most experienced team in the conference, loaded with VHT's and losing just 13 lettermen, but they also have the schedule conducive to an unbeaten season. None of their road foes finished with a winning record and if they take care of business in Death Valley, this year shapes up just like their magical 2003 season.
