NCSt has an excellent defense and is undervalued. Last year NCSt's defense allowed just 221 ypg, the best total in the NCAA. While they have just 5 starters back on that side of the ball, they will be tough once again, led by a dominating defensive front. The value part comes in the fact that NCSt was -17 in turnovers last year AND in ACC play. Despite their 3-5 record, they actually outgained league foes by 100.2 ypg, which was the BEST mark in the league. They lose 17 lettermen, which is the 2nd fewest in the conference. This Wolfpack team should get back to a bowl this year and have a much stronger season.
