In 2001 this team finished 11-1, including their Fiesta Bowl blowout of Colorado. Last year they put too much emphasis on Cal. In P10 play, Oregon outgained their first six Pac 10 foes by an average of 98.3 ypg. That would have been the third best mark in the league but they could not recover from the blown opportunity vs Cal (lost by 1) and were blown out in the final 2 games, which cost them a bowl. The Ducks have 14 starters returning, including QB Clemons. RB Whitehead ('04 #1 rusher) may lose his job to Jonathan Stewart. They also have an upgraded receiving corps. Last year's Duck team underachieved and this year's is capable of contending for the Pac 10 crown should they come together and be that unbeatable team in Autzen Stadium that they've been in the past (host USC and Cal).
