In the last 3 years, OSU has outgained Pac 10 foes by 67.8 ypg in 2002, 141.8 ypg in 2003, which was the best mark in the league, despite a 4-4 Pac 10 record and last year by 52.3 ypg. After a slow start, they needed a 5-1 finish to get to a bowl. They accomplished that and then blew out rival Oregon in the Civil War and then ND in the bowl by a combined 88-42. They must replace QB Anderson but have plenty of talent returning, although the 13 starters back ties them for 2nd lowest in the league. They are the only team in the Pac 10 to avoid USC. OSU expanded their stadium to 43,000 and no longer has the smallest venue in the league. We give them a great shot at achieving another winning season and finishing in the upper half of the P10.
