A look at the Boilermakers last year shows an average 7-5 record, including a bowl loss. Upon closer inspection, "if" Purdue had just 5 specific plays go their way, they would have actually been 12-0, as they suffered last minute losses to Wisconsin, Michigan, Northwestern, Iowa and Ariz St. That was a Purdue team with just 3 returning starters on defense and they nearly arrived a year early. This year's squad, despite having to replace QB Kyle Orton, is much stronger as they have 2 capable QB's, a deep backfield, a loaded offense and a defense that simply returns all 11 starters. Purdue outgained Big 10 foes by 80.5 ypg last year, the 3rd best mark in the league, despite their 4-4 finish. Now for the good news; Purdue not only returns 18 starters but they avoid both Ohio St and Michigan. We will call for them to run the table and grab the Big 10 Title and possibly a berth in the Rose Bowl!
