Unfortunately, numbers figure to be low this year after yet another coaching change so it appears to be of a rebuilding season. They had 3 winnable WAC home games but do not have much of a home field edge as last year they drew just 6,479 to the games. It may take Tomey time to turn that figure around as well. Last year in WAC play, SJSt finished just 1-7 and were outgained by an average of 108 ypg, the worst mark in the league, giving them a lot of ground to make up. We think they will top last year's 1 conference-win total and show improvement in 2005.
