The Vols were 7-1 in SEC play last year, have 17 starters back (9 LY) and have all the momentum in the world from their big Cotton Bowl win. Upon closer inspection, last year the Vols only outgained SEC foes by 14.5 ypg, which was the 7th best mark in the conference and only outscored them by 2 ppg with the defense, yielding 32.8 ppg over their final 4 SEC games. They also have to play Florida and LSU on the road to open the season. Tenn does have top rated O-lines and D-lines in the league which makes them a threat and the Top 3 in the SEC East are all Top 10 caliber teams.
