The Longhorns have lost all 5 games to Oklahoma this millennium. Despite the fact that UT outgained Big 12 foes by 106.2 ypg, they did have some narrow escapes. Missouri had an 18-15 FD edge but the Horns prevailed by 8 and they trailed Okla St 35-14 at the half before rallying for 42 points in the 2H. They trailed Kansas 23-13 with 4:11 left but got a fortuitous pass interference call and were able to get a TD with just :11 left and they also beat Michigan on a last play FG in the Rose Bowl. Still, this UT team is the most talented Brown has fielded. Texas has 16 returning starters and deserves to be one of the favorites to make it to the Rose Bowl. This should be the year Mack Brown finally breaks through and defeats the Sooners and wins his first ever Big 12 crown.
