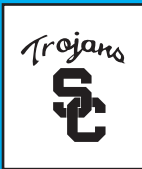

USC proved in the Orange Bowl that they were the best team in the county and are an even more veteran group in 2005. Probably the biggest question for them is who will they face in the Rose Bowl?
