Nobody expected them to win the ACC last year but when they won at the Orange Bowl with a 15-7 FD edge vs Miami, they took home their first ever ACC Crown. This year they are an even stronger team and looking at the schedule they get Miami at home in November, which should make them one of the preseason favorites in the ACC Coastal Division. They improved defensively last year by allowing just 12.8 ppg and should have one of the best units in the ACC once again this year. VT outscored ACC competition by 14.5 ppg last year which was the best mark in the league and is clearly capable of defending their league crown.
