UVA had 7 players drafted this year, the 2nd most in the ACC. In 2002 Groh had just 6 seniors overall and 29 lettermen returning which was the school's lowest total since 1981. They earned a bowl bid and finished #22 in the country after an impressive bowl win. Groh had 15 starters back in 2003 and the team went 8-5, their first back-to-back 8-win season since '94-'95. Just 16 lettermen departed last year, UVA had just 10 offensive turnovers, the lowest in the ACC since 1987 and blew out their first five opponents by an average of 30.8 ppg! They were 5-0, #6 in the polls and ranked higher than Florida St when they travelled to Tallahassee and were crushed 36-3. The Cavs have just 12 starters returning this year which is the 2nd fewest in the ACC and the 23 lettermen lost is the 2nd most but they could be a surprise team.
