Troubling is the fact that they were outgained by 84.7 ypg in ACC play, the second worst mark, showing they have quite a bit of ground to make up and, of course, the ACC gets even more talented this year with the addition of BC. WF only has 4 senior starters, the fewest in the league and we'll call them one year away from moving up in the ACC.
