The team was decimated by injuries and also put on probation while they only had 7 seniors in the 2 deep last year, which was the fewest in the Pac 10. Turnovers killed them as they were -19 and lost 3 Pac 10 games they could easily have won. At one point the receivers, OL, DL and LB's were so banged up that all 5 of their captains were on the sidelines with injuries. They have 19 returning starters and if they have some early season success vs a softer schedule, they may buy into Willingham's program. The Huskies have our #4 defense in the Pac 10. The Huskies were just 1-10 last year, their first losing season in 27 years. This team is actually capable of getting back to the plus side of the ledger.
